

- Wiping
 - Normal way of putting a machine into dfu mode sucks.
 - Macdvm tool, faster and easier
 - <https://github.com/AsahiLinux/macvdmttool>
 - Has to be compiled with xcode and development
 - Can be used in scripts
 - Apple configurator
 - Easiest to wipe multiple and update and solve problems.
 - DEMO
 - Put a machine into dfu mode with macvdm tool
 - Use apple configurator to wipe the machine
- Classlink SSO
 - Platform SSO
 - Device itself becomes the authenticator
 - Provides secure tokens to the IdP enabling seamless authentication between web and native applications.

 - Identity providers that support Platform SSO
 - Microsoft Entra Id
 - Okta
 - ClassLink
 - ClassLink > Microsoft
 - ClassLink has an implementation of simplified setup (mostly touchless)
 - Simplified setup allows you to register with your IdP during the setup assistant.
 - ClassLink has an implementation for Password Authenticated Guest Mode
 - Working on Quick card authentication method (Works with Mac os 27)
 - Classlink SSO
 - MDM is required (Jamf works for sure)
 - ClassLink needs to be able to authenticate with Active Directory for now
 - Supports
 - Secure enclave Authentication
 - Password Authentication Mode (Password Sync)
 - Authenticated Guest mode
 - Cool because it creates accounts on the fly
 - Files are maintained for up to 8 hours.
