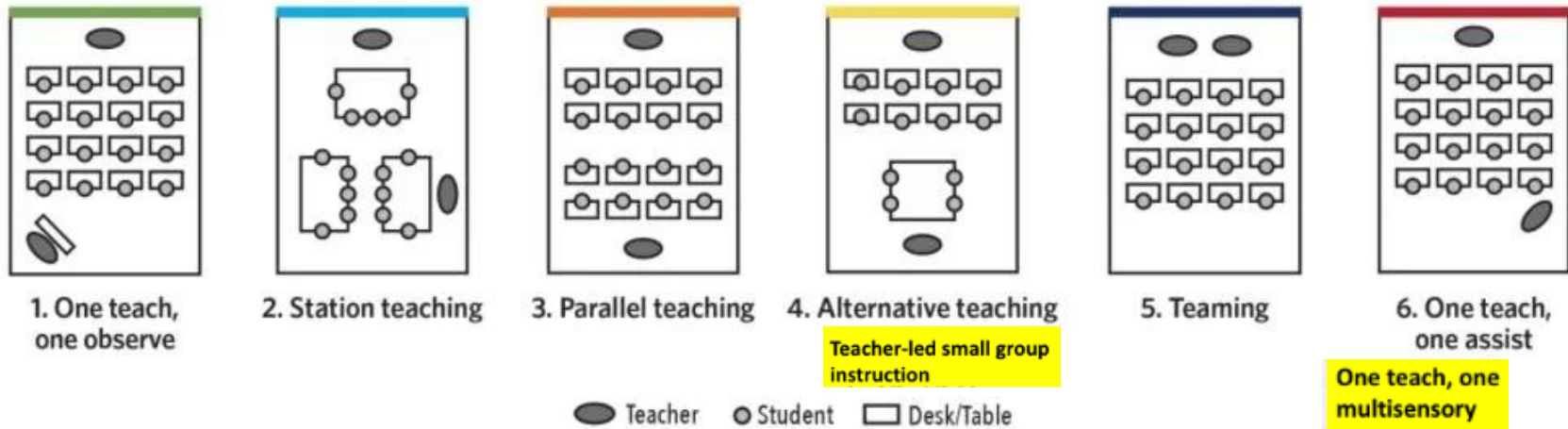

Co-Teaching Models Quick Reference

Co-Teaching Models



1. **One Teach/ One Observe:** One Teaches, One Assesses
2. **Station Teaching:** Two Monitor/Teach
3. **Parallel Teaching:** Two Teach the Same Content (Two Groups)
4. **Alternative (Small Group) Teaching:** One Preteaches or Reteaches, One Teaches Alternate Information
5. **Team Teaching:** Two Teach the Same Content (One Group)
6. **One Teach/One Assist:** One Leads, One “Teaches on Purpose”
