

Problem Statement

Use this worksheet to define a clear work-based learning problem grounded in systems realities before creating solutions.

<p>Gap: What is your work-based learning problem? What are you trying to solve for?</p>	
<p>Impact: Who does the problem involve, and who is affected? How would you define the audience(s)?</p>	
<p>Context: Where does the problem occur? How would you geographically define the region?</p>	
<p>Importance: Why does the problem matter? What will or won't happen if this problem isn't solved?</p>
