

Triand Reports that Raise the Grade

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Triand Overview



- Triand is a user-friendly way to transfer student transcripts between districts, schools and colleges.
- When a student transfers from an Arkansas public school or charter schools to another Arkansas public school or charter school, the first step is for the “new” school to send a Triand Transcript Request to the previous school. This serves as the official request for records and indicates to the previous school to withdraw the student from eSchool within 24 hours because the student is actively enrolled at the “new” school.
- Public schools, charter schools, and universities in Arkansas are required to use the electronic transcript system pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 6-80-107.
- Triand connects to both eFinancePLUS and eSchoolPLUS nightly.

- Students who joined your district on-time or caught up to be on-time

- Verify cohort membership and transfer status.

Completion Status Report



What can it be used for?

- Shows where students may have a gap in their additional graduation requirements.
- Run at the beginning of the year to see what students need to complete before graduation.
- Can help prevent a student from missing a crucial step to graduation.

Application:

- Identify seniors missing graduation requirements.
- Monitor completion of state-mandated graduation components.
- Develop plans with students to close requirement gaps.
- Prevent last-minute graduation eligibility issues.

- Dual Enrolled students are students enrolled in a district and in the Home School Database (NOI).

- ADM: Filter students that have a Part Time ADM, Full Time or include all students.
- No Aggregations: Displays all students in the State that meet the report criteria.

- Monitor and identify students who are receiving EFA and are enrolled in the district.
- Verify students that should only be there for a portion of the day and have partial ADM.

- Looks at all currently enrolled students who completed the specified test during Spring 2025 administration (e.g., 8th Grade Math).
