Instructions:

1. Scan the QR code with your phone.
2. Fill in your email address to receive an email with a **unique** link.
4. Go to your email **on your desktop** to open the email.
4. The link takes you to a registration page. **You need to use the same email they just entered on the phone.**
5. Once registered, you get automatic access without verification and can open Lovable without needing to wait.
6. In the dashboard, click Open **Lovable**, and then you will need to copy the username and password from the Imagi Dashboard for Lovable.

Go to <https://brisk-teaching.com/rachelle-dene-poth>, enter your email, then add Brisk by **creating an account** with a Microsoft/Google SSO (or separate email). To access Brisk Premium (3 months), you will need to **click the button** in the email from Brisk (sent upon step 2 of entering their email)

This is both teacher and student-facing. Start with a presentation, then create DOK questions, a quiz, more slides, notes, and more. Generate a podcast based on a presentation, website, document, and many other ideas. Brisk Next has ready-to-use templates and activities.

Grab a YouTube video, website, and create a variety of activities for students. Now there is also **Brisk Next**, which helps you to create more materials for your classroom, based on your specific interests!

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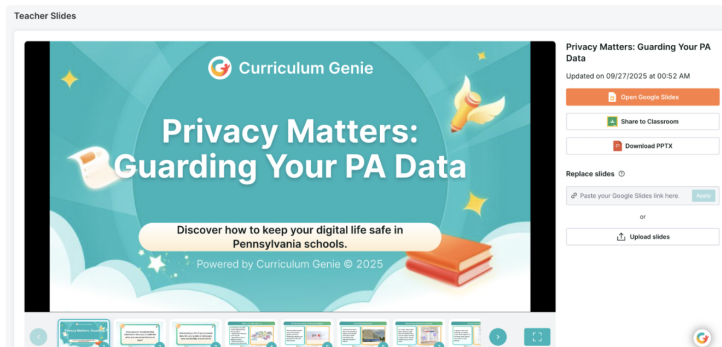

Ensuring transparency and accountability is essential for ethical AI integration in schools.

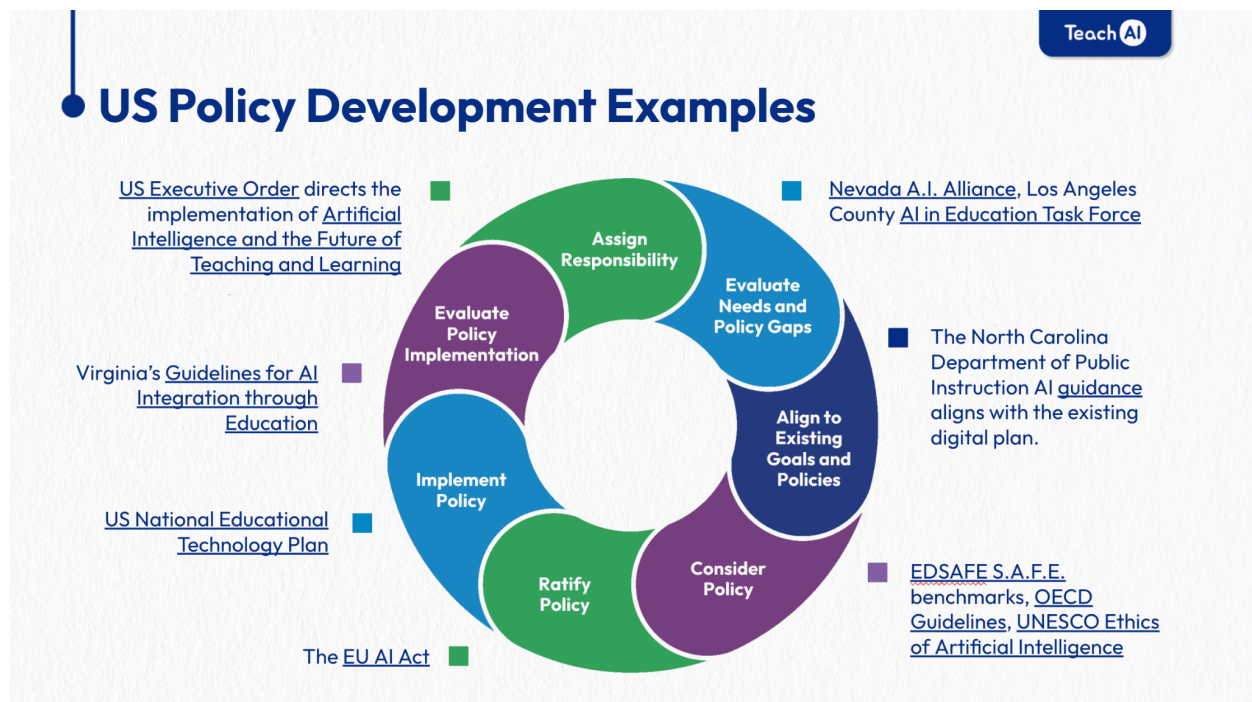
Regulatory Framework

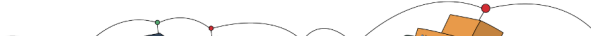
