

DIY PINATA HELPFUL TIPS

Try out different glue and find what works for you. It may be a mix of different types of glue. Hot glue works well because it dries quickly.

 **Hot glue is hot! Use caution.**

Steps to crafting a mini pinata:

1. Grab a stencil or free-hand your own design on posterboard, cardstock or a recycled cardboard box.
2. Cut out the design (x2)
3. Cut out strips of posterboard or cardstock in 1 inch strips (or larger for thicker pinatas).
4. Start by lining up the paperboard strips around one of your cutout designs and taping them together with the masking tape.
5. Tape the other design cutout on top.
6. If you are putting a hole for candy, make sure you plan for that before you start with the next step.
7. Glue strips of tissue paper to the sides of the pinata with the colors you will use.
8. Cutout strips of tissue paper (in a fringe pattern).
9. Glue the fringe tissue paper from the bottom up.
