**ORDER GRANTING RESTORATION OF CITIZENSHIP RIGHTS
PURSUANT TO TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED § 40-29-103**

This matter came before the Court on the Petition of _____ to restore their rights of citizenship for the felony convictions listed in their Petition. The Court has reviewed the pleadings in this matter and the evidence presented by the parties. The Court makes the following findings:

1. The State of Tennessee, through the relevant District Attorney(s) General, received notice as required by Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-29-103(c) and ☐ **did** / ☐ **did not** [**check one**] object to the restoration of rights.
