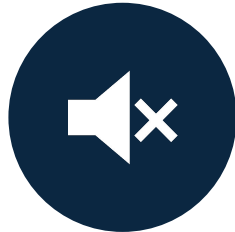

Recommendations

1. Continue MPC

MPC fulfills its purpose; the purpose of MPC is aligned with the ccNSO strategic goal to serve as a platform for information sharing for and by ccTLDs, focusing on topics relevant to ccTLD Managers

2. Clarify Agenda setting

The process and procedures for setting the ccNSO agendas for ICANN meetings are currently undocumented. The MPC's role needs to be better understood and reflected in a clarification of the meetings guideline.

3. Update the MPC Charter and meeting Guideline

Update the current charter in conjunction with the meeting Guideline to align roles, responsibilities, and decisions with current MPC practices, and to show how MPC actions are reflected in ICANN meeting agendas.

4. ccNSO Meeting Strategy

Council and MPC should be willing to challenge the meeting structure within the confines of ICANN's overall planning. This is not in the scope of the review team, but it is a sentiment that emerged and goes to the overarching planning for meetings. Find ways to leverage Continuous Improvement methods.

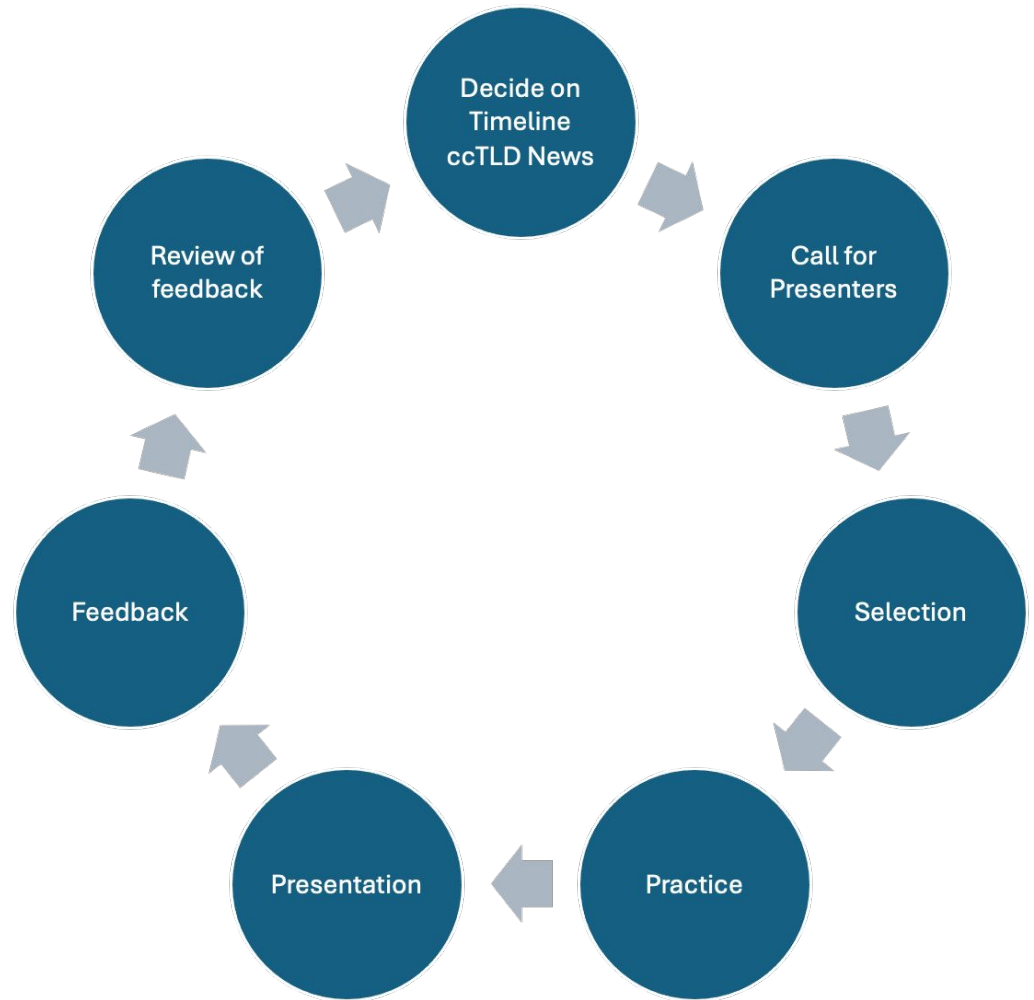
