One-Time Funding Redirections



- Safe Routes to School Constuction: \$17M
- Oregon Community Paths: \$8M
- Innovative Mobility: \$5M
- Community Charging Rebates: \$8M
- Connect Oregon: \$42M

Oregon Transportation Infrastructure Bank (OTIB)

- OTIB is a statewide revolving loan fund to promote innovative financing solutions for transportation needs
- Loans can cover up to 100% of project costs
- Low interest, high value

Carbon Reduction: COMING SOON!

- Approximately \$2.5M will be available for cities, counties, tribal governments, transit districts in Small Urban and Rural Areas:
 - Some funding for areas with pop less than 50,000
 - Bulk of funding for areas with pop less than 5,000
- Federal funding for projects that reduce GHG from transportation
- Expected to open in late May



Innovative Mobility: COMING SOON!

- **Capital and Equipment Grants**
 - Approximately \$4.1M in federal funding
 - Shared mobility projects including micromobility & microtransit
 - Includes both IMP and CRP funding
 - 10.27% match requirement
- **Service Expansion Grants**
 - Approximately \$2.3M in state funding
 - Expansion of existing shared mobility services including funds for operations and minor infrastructure
 - 10.27% match requirement with options



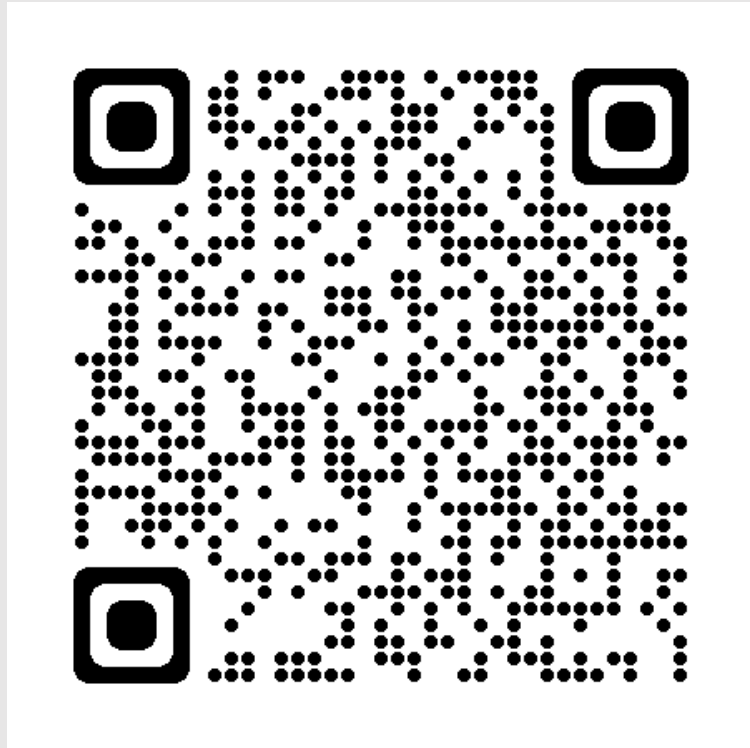
Innovative Mobility: COMING SOON!

- **Transportation Wallet Grants (NEW!)**
 - Approximately \$1.3M in federal CRP funding
 - TDM strategy that includes passes or credits for one or more mobility options
