Isaiah 59:14–15	“Truth has stumbled in the public squares...Truth is lacking.”	When people reject God’s standard, truth is pushed aside, and those who reject evil may become targets.	John 8:44
John 8:44	“He is a liar and the father of lies.”	Lying is Satan’s character. His goal is deception and death.	John 8:32
John 8:32	“The truth will set you free.”	The answer to deception is knowing, believing, and obeying the truth.	John 14:6
John 14:6	“I am...the truth.”	Truth is not something we invent. Jesus is the Truth and the way to life.	John 17:17
John 17:17	“Your word is truth.”	God’s Word—not feelings, culture, or popularity—is our standard of truth.	Romans 1:21–25
Romans 1:21–25	“They exchanged the truth about God for a lie.”	Sin grows when the creature rejects the Creator’s truth and believes a lie instead.	2 Corinthians 11:3
2 Corinthians 11:3	“The serpent deceived Eve by his cunning.”	Satan still tries to lead minds away from sincere devotion to Christ.	2 Corinthians 11:14
2 Corinthians 11:14	“Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.”	Deception often looks attractive, harmless, or even good.	Ephesians 6:11
Ephesians 6:11	“Stand against the schemes of the devil.”	We must recognize that Satan plans and schemes; God gives us armor to stand.	James 1:14–16
James 1:14–16	“Do not be deceived.”	Desire gives birth to sin, and sin brings death. Do not mistake temptation for something good.	1 Peter 5:8–9
1 Peter 5:8–9	“Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion.”	Be watchful. Resist him, firm in your faith.	Revelation 12:9–11
Revelation 12:9–11	“The deceiver of the whole world...they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb.”	The ancient serpent is Satan, but Christ’s people overcome through the Lamb.	Revelation 20:10
Revelation 20:10	“The devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire.”	The deceiver does not get the final word. Satan will be defeated forever. Jesus wins.	End
