- **Key text:** 1 Peter 4:9.

- It is expected in qualified leaders.

- **Key texts:** 1 Timothy 3:2; 1 Timothy 5:9–10.

5. HOSPITALITY CAN IMPACT ANOTHER SOUL

- Open homes can open hearts.
- A simple welcome may become encouragement, comfort, and connection.
- **Key thought:** Impact Another Soul.

2. HOSPITALITY BELONGS TO EVERYDAY DISCIPLESHIP

- Hospitality stands alongside diligence, prayer, hope, and care for others.
- Showing hospitality is one way we serve the Lord.
- **Key text:** Romans 12:11–13.

4. HOSPITALITY WELCOMES MORE THAN FRIENDS

- Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers.
- God can use ordinary welcome in extraordinary ways.
- **Key text:** Hebrews 13:1–2.

6. HOSPITALITY HELPS US LIVE OUT THE GOSPEL

- We give to others the welcome and kindness God has shown us.
- Given what was given; live out the gospel.
- **Key thoughts:** Given What Was Given; Live out the Gospel.
