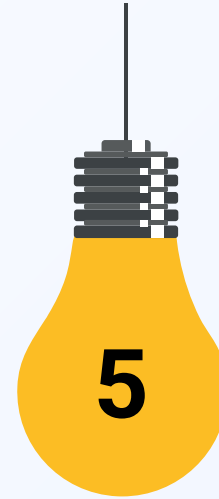
A Comprehensive view of curriculum for the year
