Legislation & Policy Implementation

[Tennessee Literacy Success Act \(2021\)](#)

Establishes a statewide framework for evidence-based literacy instruction, universal reading screeners, interventions, and educator training to ensure students are reading proficiently by the end of third grade.

[Tennessee Learning Loss and Remediation Act \(2021\)](#)

Creates statewide summer learning camps, bridge camps, and other acceleration supports to address COVID-19-related learning loss and accelerate student achievement.

[K-8 Math Support Act \(2024\)](#)

Requires the state to analyze K-8 mathematics achievement and teacher preparation, convene expert reviewers, and provide a standards-aligned mathematics professional development pathway for educators.

Networks for District & Regional Support

[Early Literacy Network 2.0](#) The Early Literacy Network 2.0 provides high-quality foundational skills professional learning to ALL districts, including charters, EPPs, and certain non-profit partners. Within the Early Literacy Network, regional support networks focus on solving similar problems of practice, sharing resources, and developing implementation support strategies to improve student learning through quality early literacy instruction.

[Literacy Materials Implementation Support Grant \(CLSD\)](#) Provides funding and implementation support to help districts effectively adopt and sustain high-quality literacy instructional materials.

[Acceleration for All](#) This statewide initiative is focused on supporting high-quality instruction for all students based on their unique instructional needs. The network combines the efforts of the Literacy Implementation Network (LIN), The Access for All Network (AALN), Center of Regional Excellence (CORE) and the Literacy Materials Implementation Support grant. By engaging in the network, districts have access to quarterly in-person regional convenings, regional district-level support virtual collaborative calls, and virtual school leader calls.

[Math Implementation Network](#) The Math Implementation Network is a district support for math HQIM implementation. This 3-year initiative will focus on math structures with a goal of targeting both district and school leaders.
