

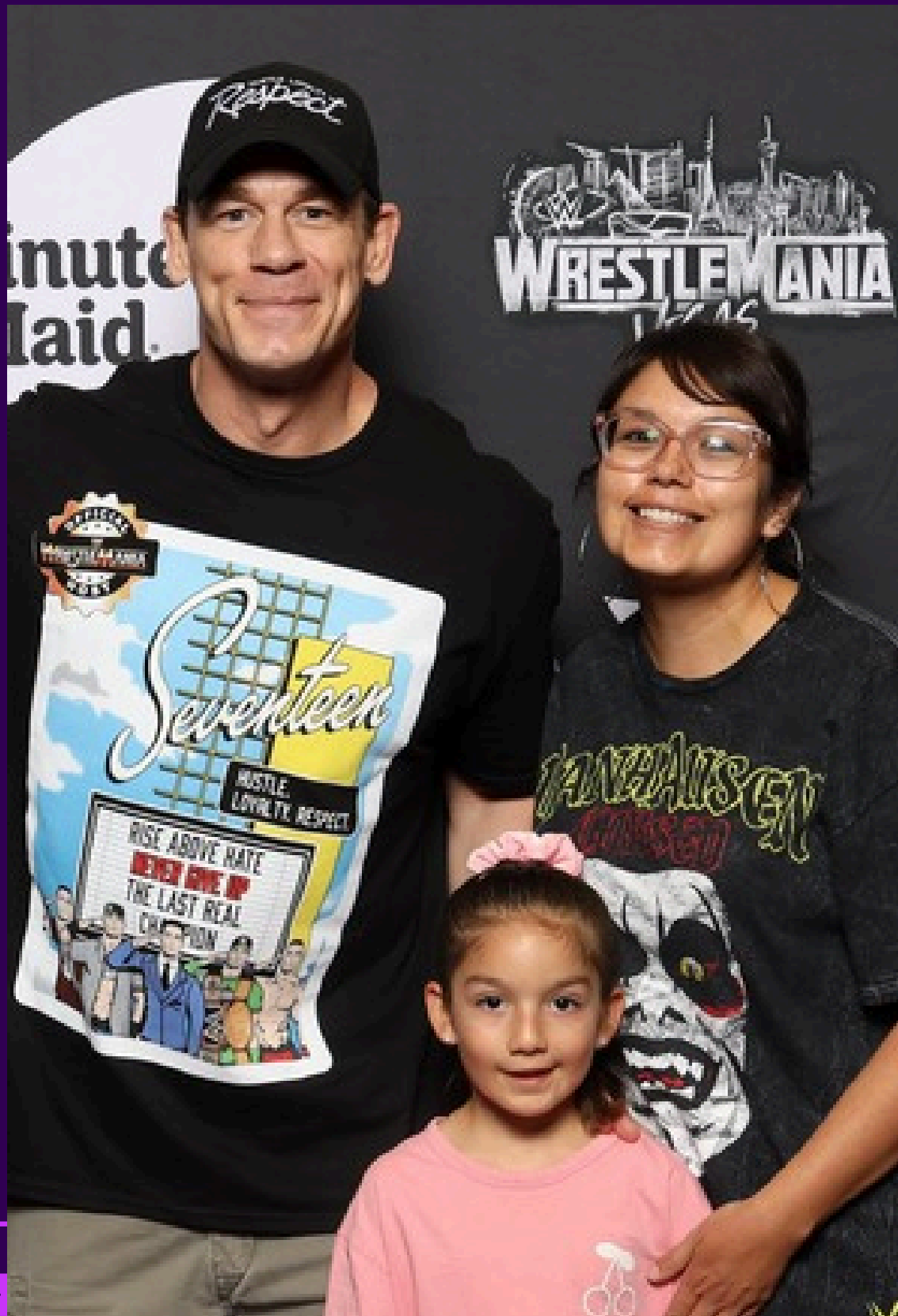

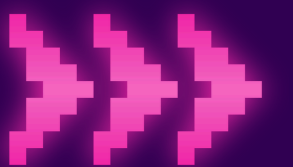

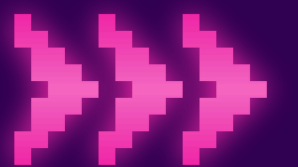
- I am a first-grade teacher at Sandia Vista Elementary.

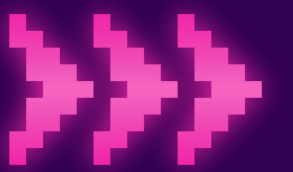

WHAT IS GIMKIT?

Gimkit is a game-based learning platform that turns quizzes into interactive games, encouraging participation, critical thinking, and friendly competition.

- Increases student engagement
- Provides formative assessment
- Encourages practice and review
- Works across grade levels and subjects

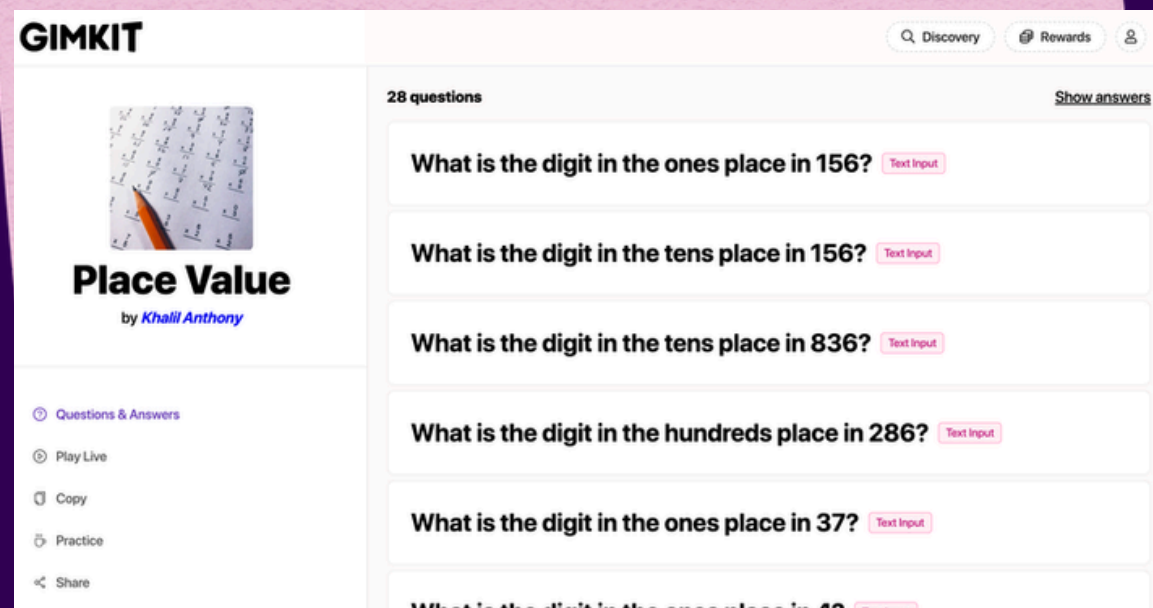


WHAT IS GIMKIT?

Gimkit is made up of “Kits” and “Game Modes”.

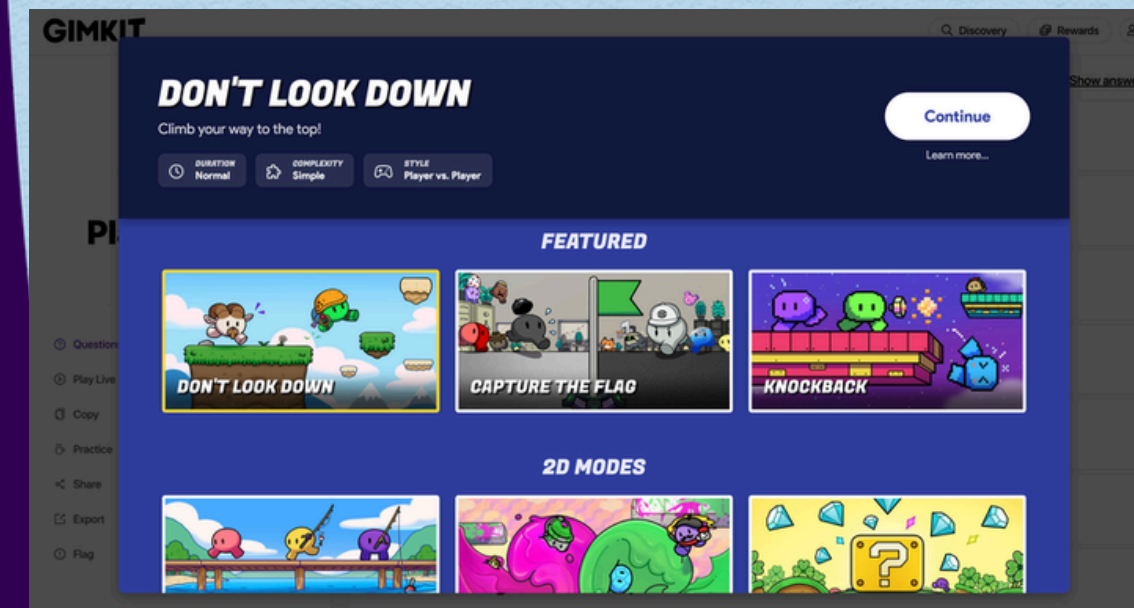
Kits

A Kit is a set of questions that you create or copy.



Game Modes

A Game Mode is how students play your Kit.



GIMKIT BASIC

What Can You Do with Gimkit Basic?

Teachers can:

-  Create unlimited Kits (sets of questions)
-  Copy and edit existing Kits
-  Host live games
-  Access 3 rotating Featured Game Modes
-  View student performance reports
-  Pro Exclusive game modes are available for up to 5 players only.

GimKit Pro:

-  Assign independent student activities
-  Unlock more game modes
-  Add images and audio to questions

CREATE A TEACHER ACCOUNT

1. Visit gimkit.com
2. Click Sign Up
3. Select Continue with Google
4. Choose Educator
5. Complete the account setup. You will be given a 14-day trial of Pro.

Important Note: Students **cannot** create their own accounts. They are only allowed to play as guests (per RRPS district guidelines)

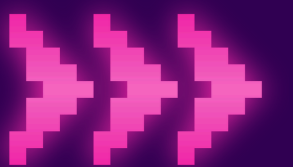
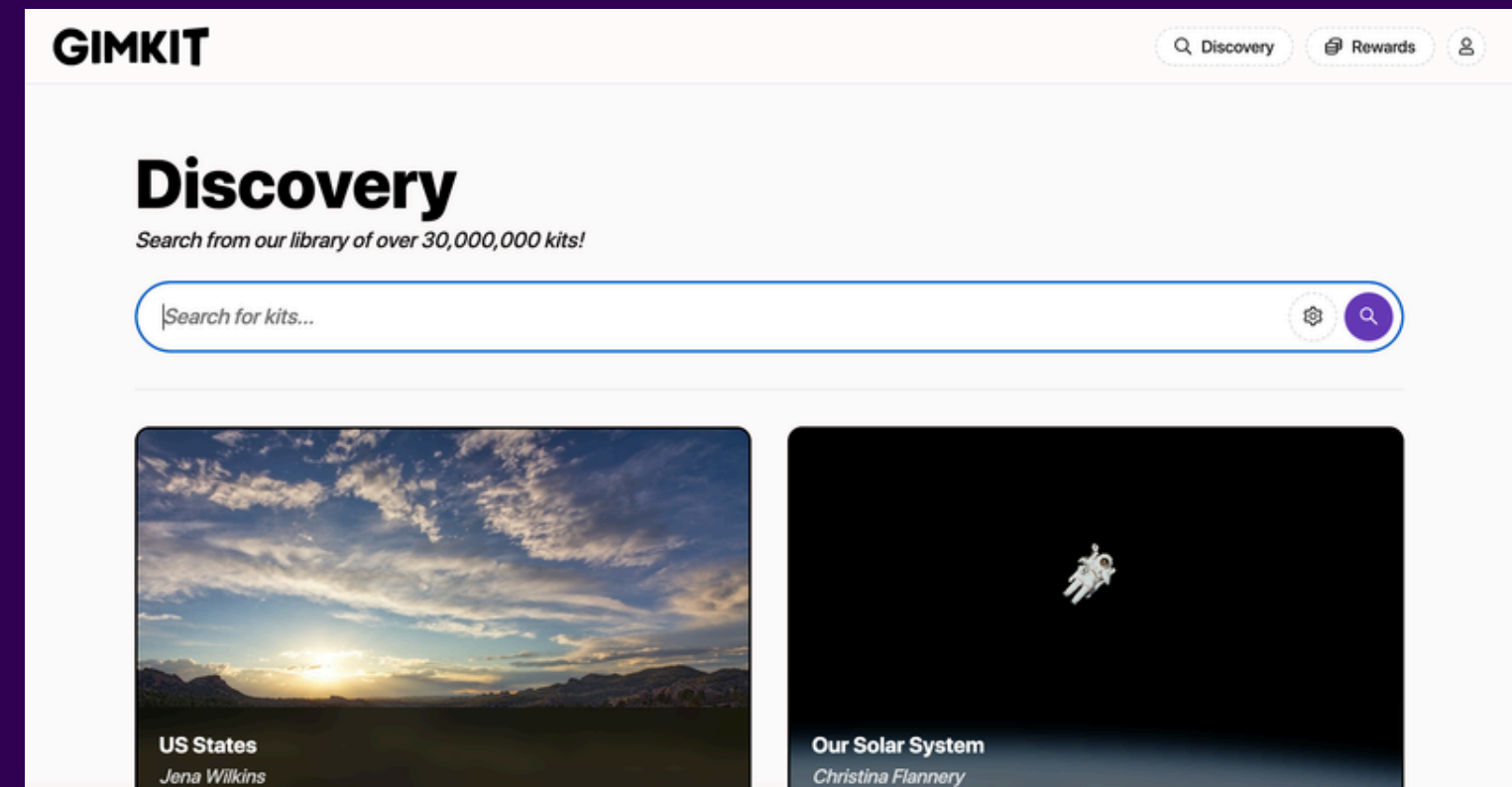

- Text input
- Images
- AI-generated questions

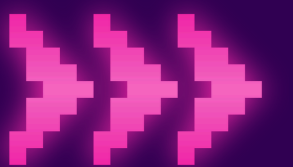
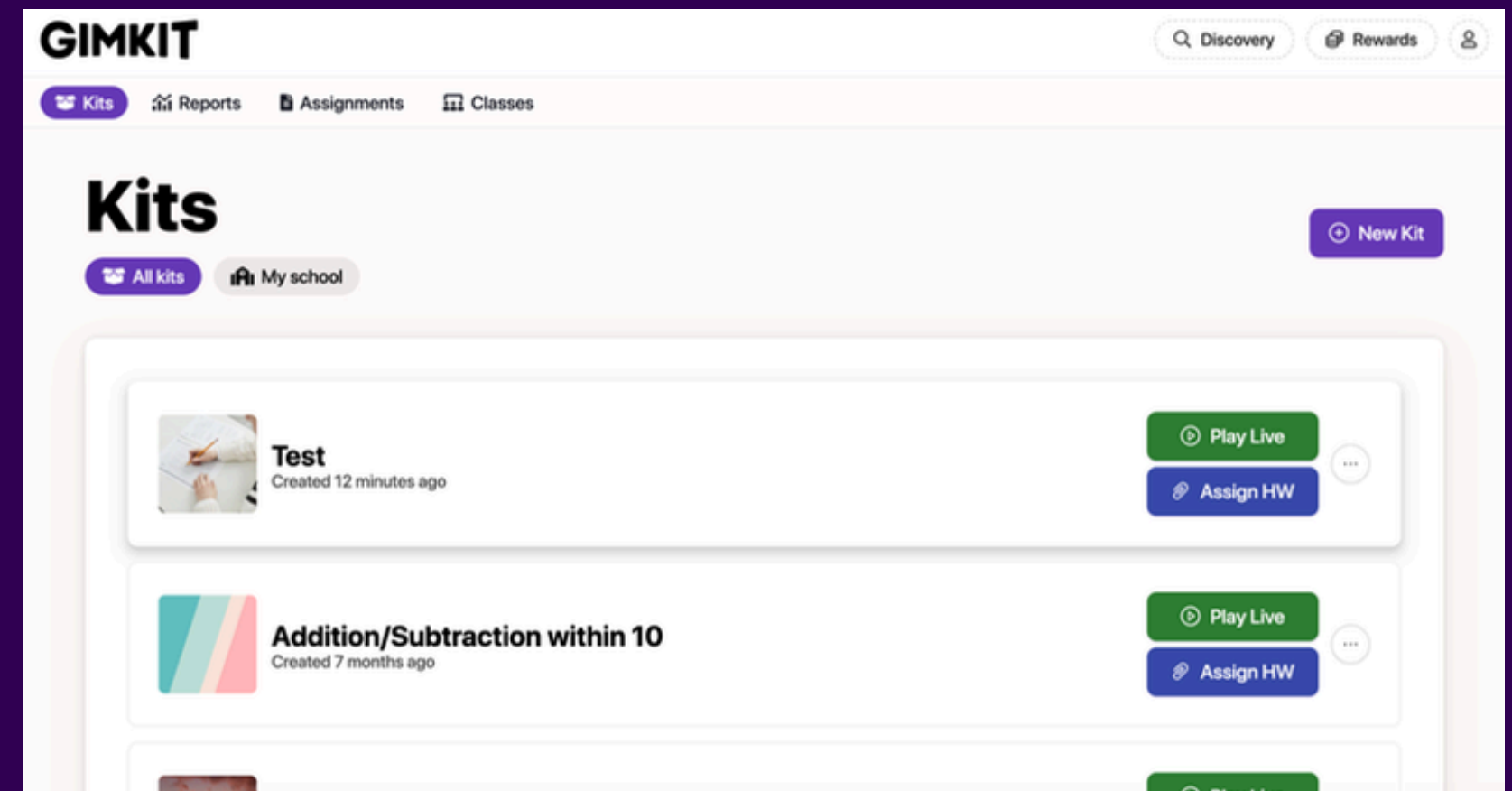
