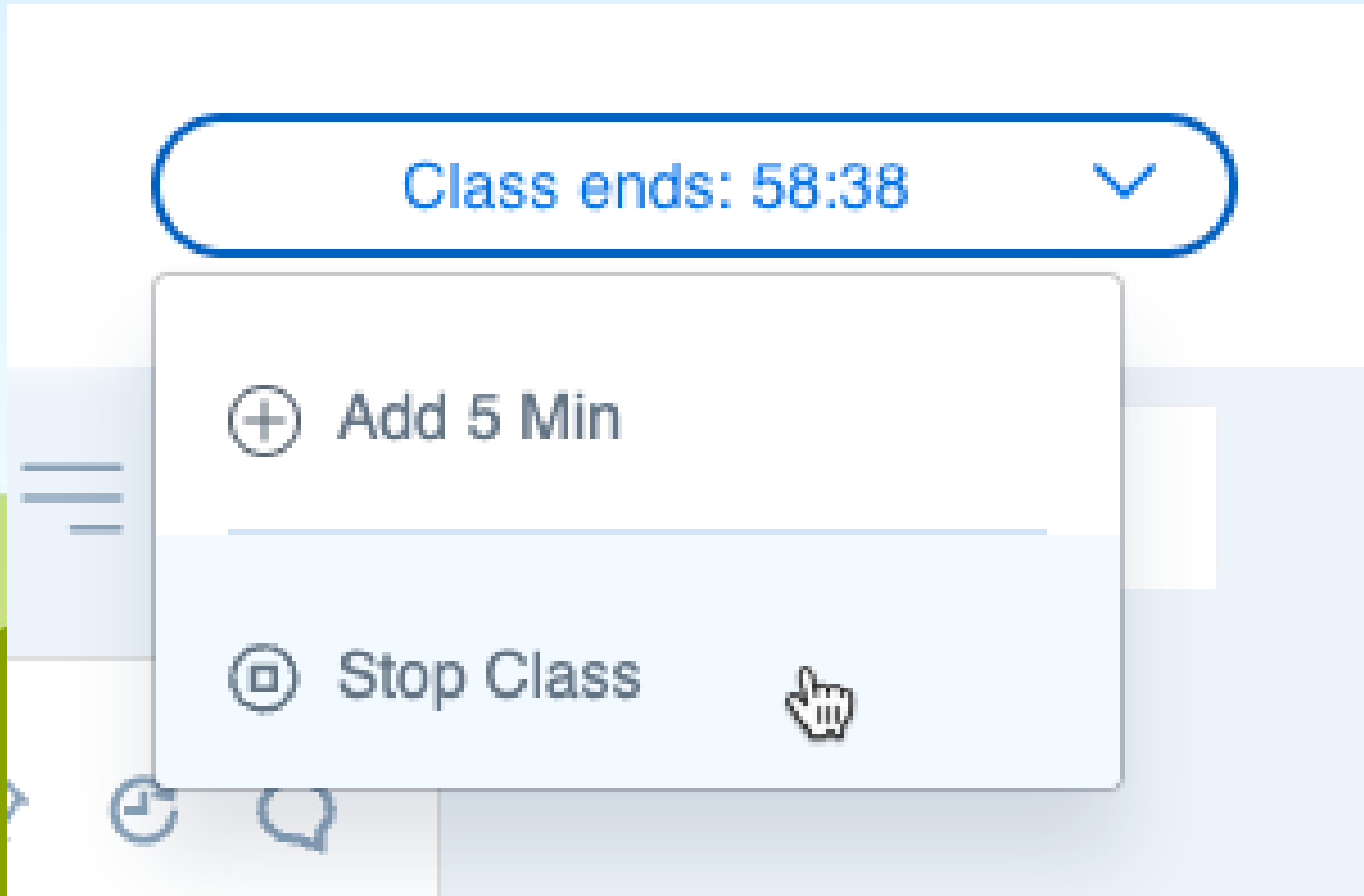
1. To start a class session, begin by going to the Classes menu. Classes will be listed as cards.
2. Locate the class you want to start, then click the start class button.
3. Remove any students who are absent, then click Continue
4. Confirm your settings before starting a class. These choices will be remembered on the same browser and computer when starting the new class.

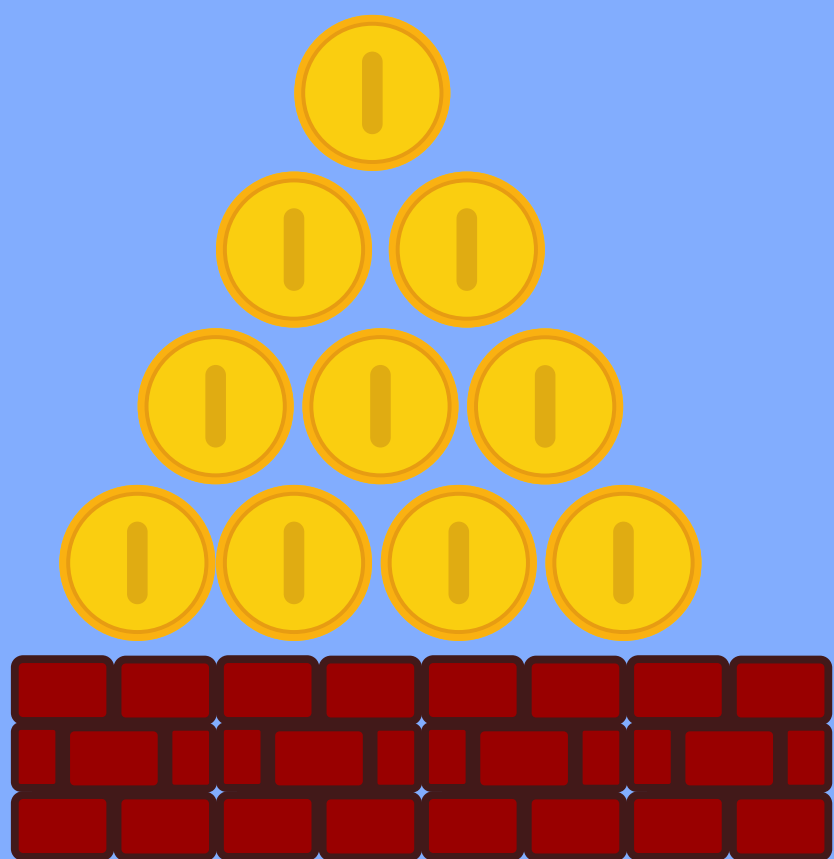

Screen Lock

Freeze screens and get your class's attention by sending a custom message (e.g. All eyes up front, please) then release individual students or the entire class at once.



Site Lock

Open and lock students to a particular website or set of websites, blocking others.



Unlock

Release individual students or the whole class from Screen Lock or Site Lock.



Teacher Tools can be applied to your whole class, groups, or individual students. Select students or groups by checking their checkbox in the upper left.



Push URL

Quickly push web pages to individual students or your entire class.



Share Screen

Share your desktop, a single tab, or an application with one student or your whole class, as well as audio remote students.



Announce

Send a message to all student advices that they must acknowledge to close (e.g. Reminder: Big test tomorrow!).



Apply Access Plan

Allow or block lists of websites and/or Windows and Mac apps.



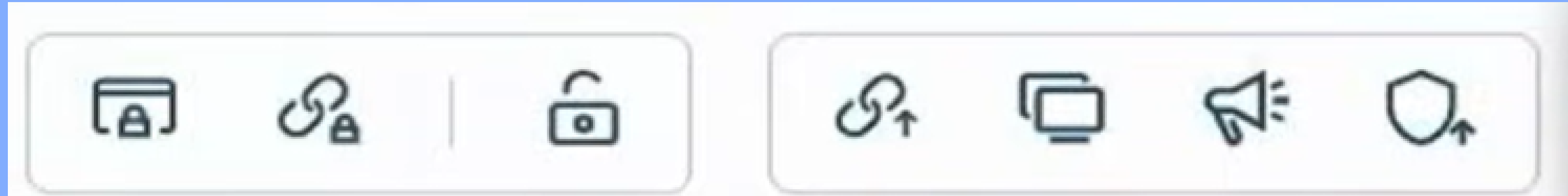

The Announce feature allows the teacher to send a message to one or more students in the class. This tool is available when a class session is active.

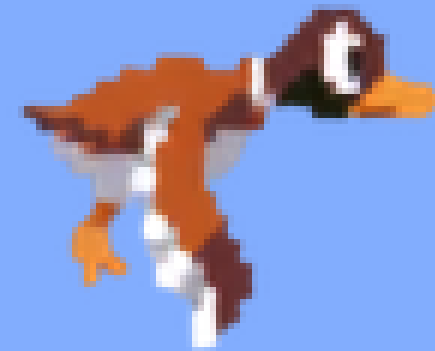

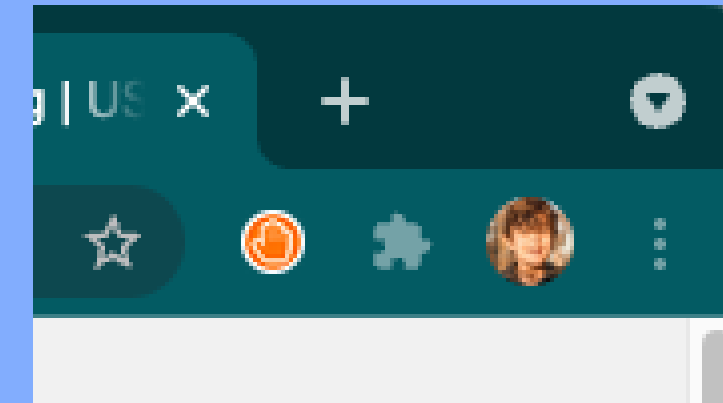

To use hand raise, students click the extension icon at the top of their browser and use the Raise hand button.

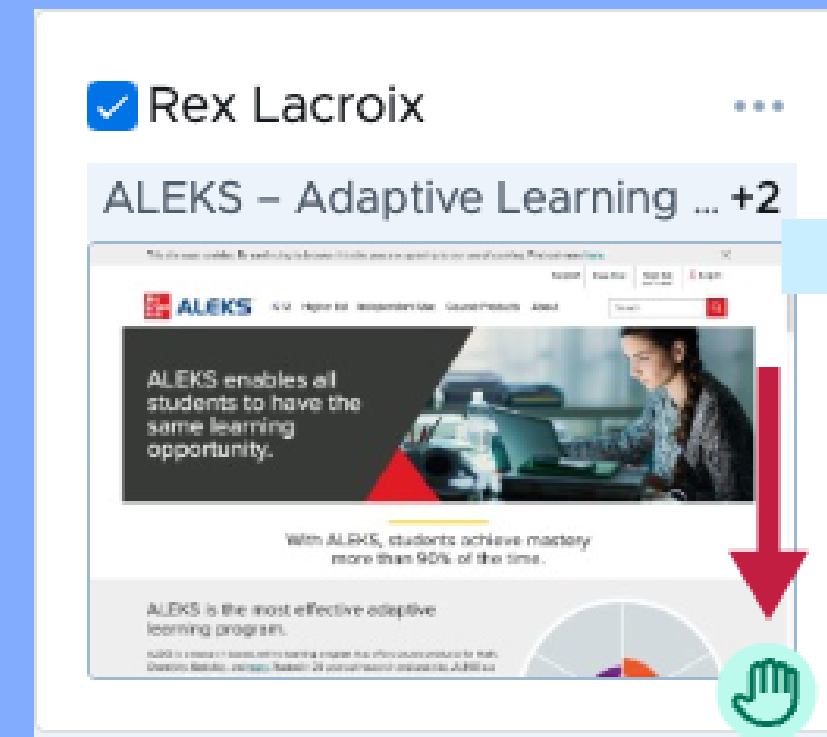
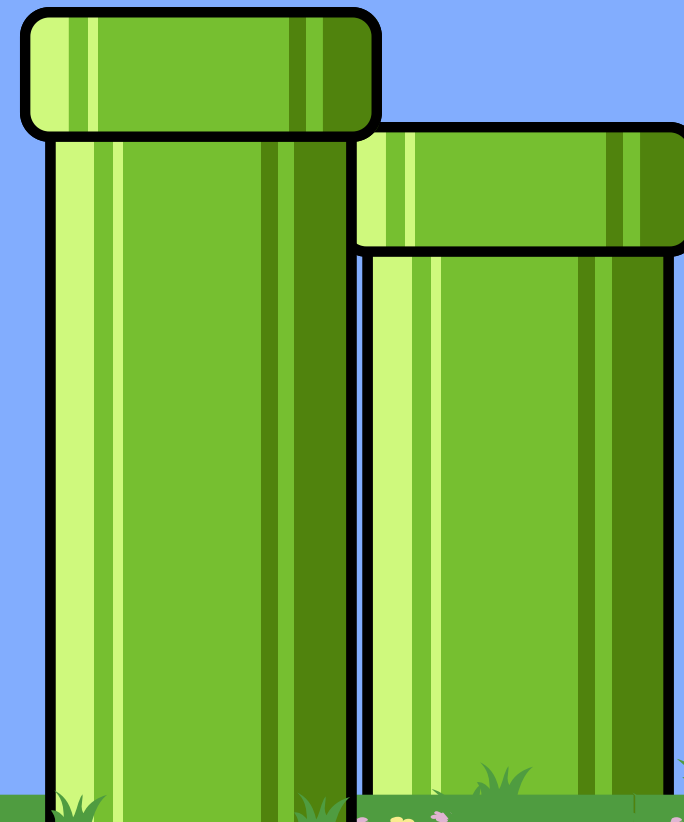

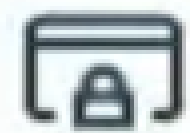

SITE LOCK ALLOWS THE TEACHER TO LOCK STUDENTS TO A SINGLE WEB SITE, OR A GROUP OF SITES. THIS TOOL IS AVAILABLE WHEN A CLASS SESSION IS ACTIVE. WITH THIS METHOD, STUDENTS WILL ONLY BE ABLE TO ACCESS THE SITES YOU DESCRIBE IN YOUR COLLECTION, AND NO OTHERS.



The Site Lock sidebar will allow you enter a single site, or choose one or more web links.



Site Lock can be applied to an entire class, or individual students.

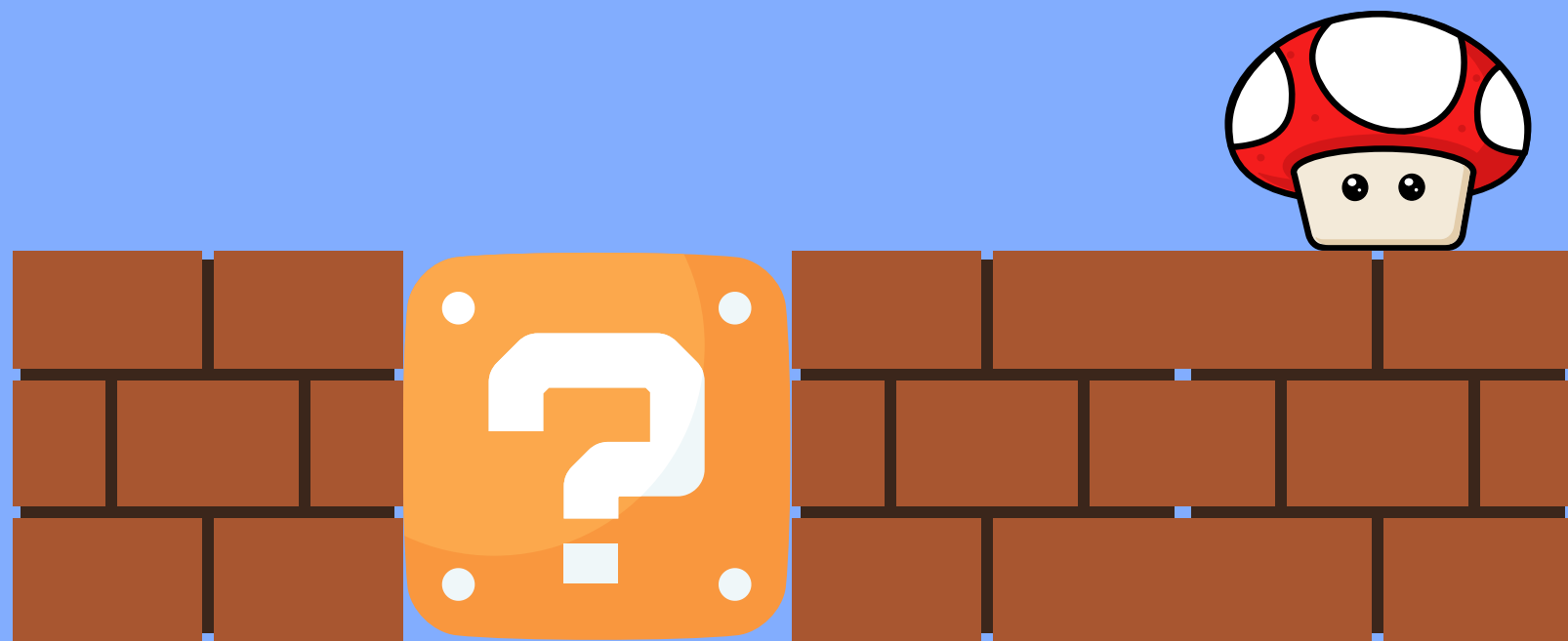
Whole Class:

To apply Site Lock to the entire class, click the Site Lock button with no students selected.

Individual Student:

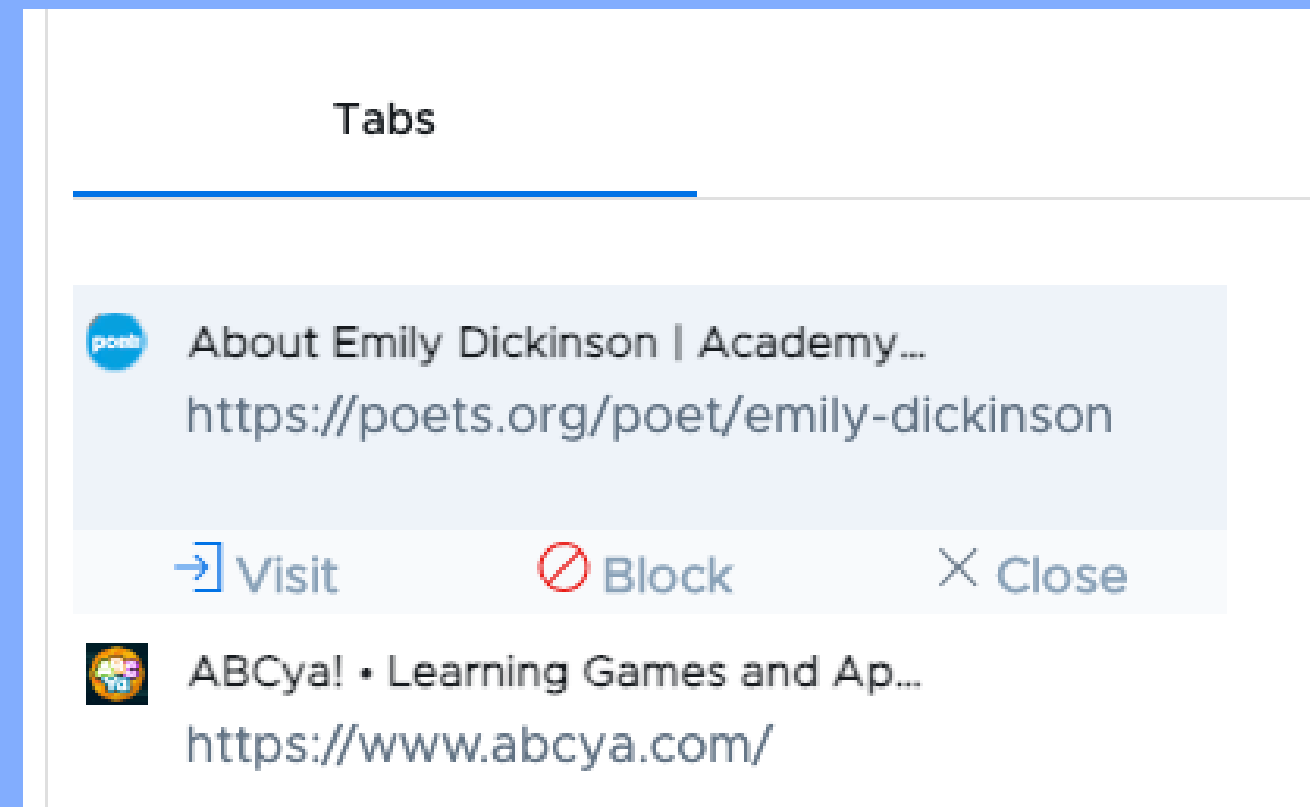

Close Tab and Add to Block list

When teachers close a tab on a student device, from tab view or detail view, they will now have the option to also add the site that was closed to the currently enabled block list so that students cannot open it again in the future.

BRING SELECTED TAB TO FRONT

TEACHERS NOW HAVE THE ABILITY TO BRING A SELECTED TAB ON A STUDENT DEVICE TO THE FRONT. THIS CAN BE USEFUL WHEN ASSISTING STUDENTS REMOTELY WHO HAVE DIFFICULTIES NAVIGATING THEIR DEVICE.

THE FEATURE IS AVAILABLE IN THE DETAIL VIEW BY DRAGGING ANY TAB FROM THE LIST OF OPEN TABS ON THE STUDENT DEVICE TO THE TOP OF THE LIST.

To create a seating chart for a class, from the Classes menu, click the three dot menu on any class card, then click Seating Chart.

When running a class, you'll see "Seating chart" as a view option in the view selector dropdown.

WHAT TO DO WHEN A STUDENT IS OFF TASK

Let the student know they need to get back on task verbally or you can send a chat message to just that student.

Close distracting tabs

Take screenshots of student screens. To save a screen, open Detail View by clicking the student's screen thumbnail, then click the Camera icon below the student screen image.

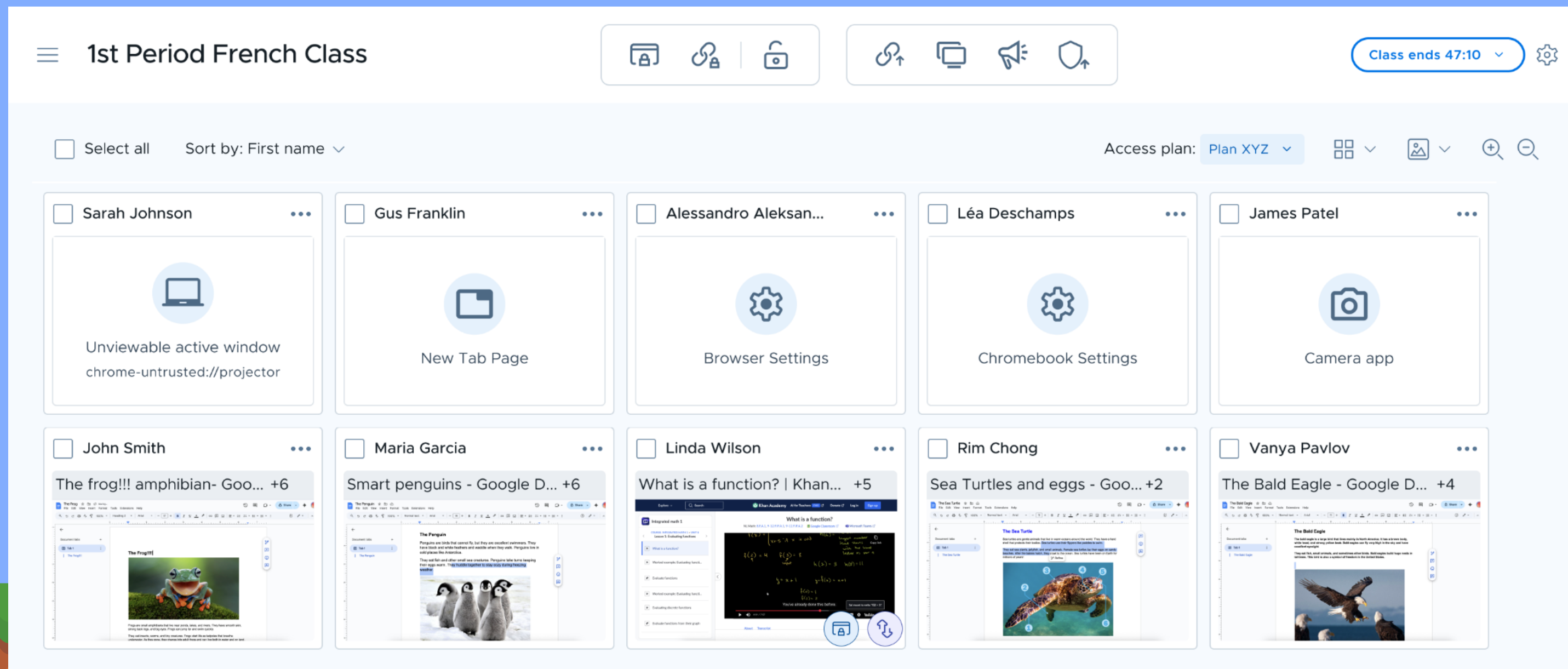
Keep a closer eye on students by moving them closer to you or pinning them.

Give a warning. Take the Chromebook away.

Close the Chromebook screen and get out a piece of paper and pencil

If you want to not only close a tab with a distracting site, but also block the site to prevent future distractions, you can click the site in tab view or device view, then click Block. This will not only close the tab, but add it to the classes currently active blocklist.

Indicate when students are in Chrome apps and pages that restrict monitoring
Teachers can now see when students visit tabs and apps on a Chromebook that do not allow screen capture such as the New Tab page, the Chromebook Camera app or the Files app.

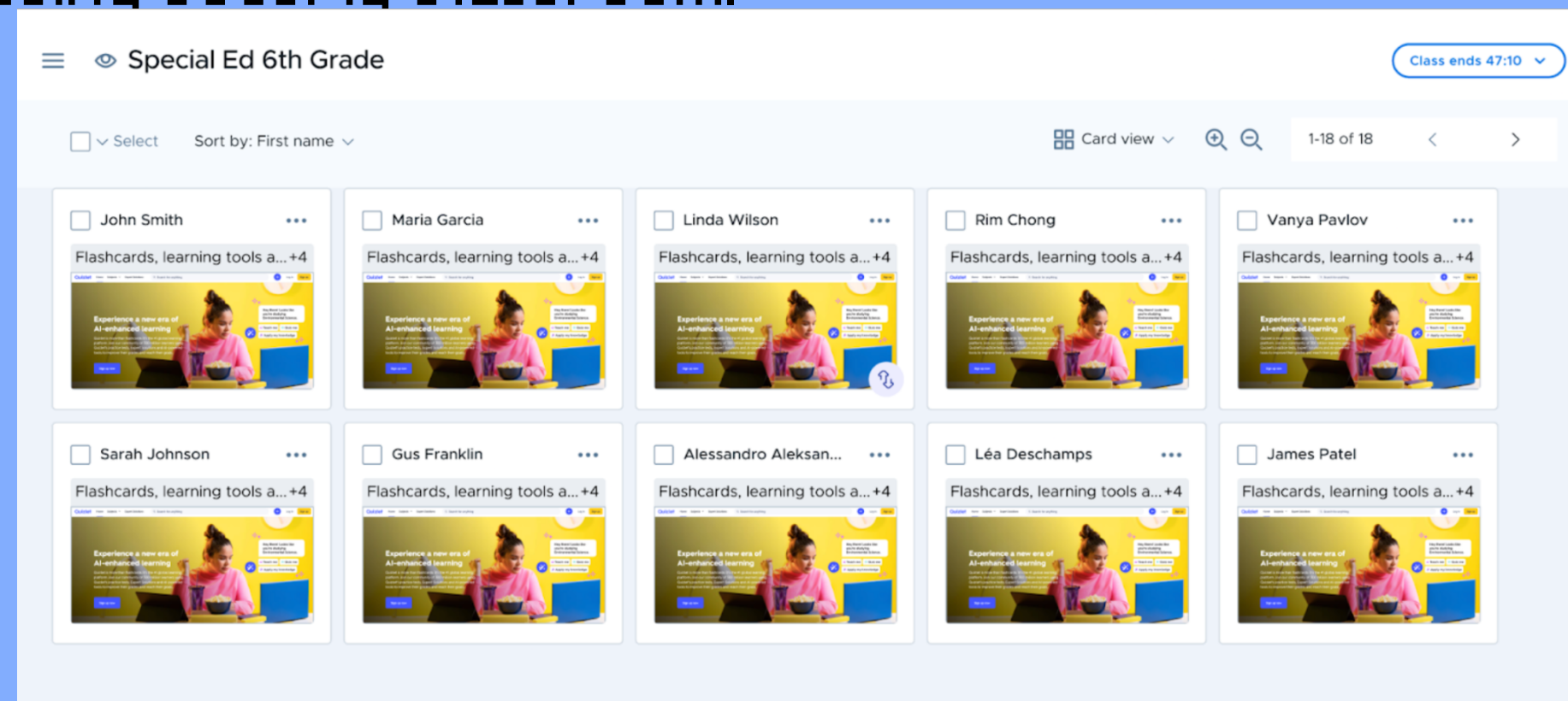

Observation Groups

The new Observation Groups feature enables additional staff, like special education teachers, to monitor specific students throughout the day, even as they switch between different classes. Meanwhile, regular classroom teachers maintain their ability to monitor and manage student devices using Securly Classroom.

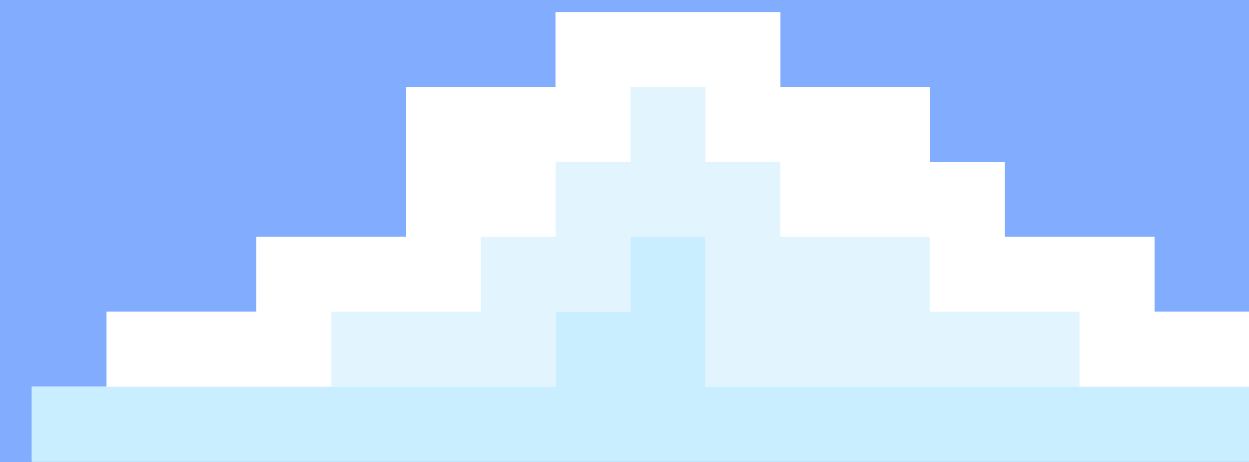
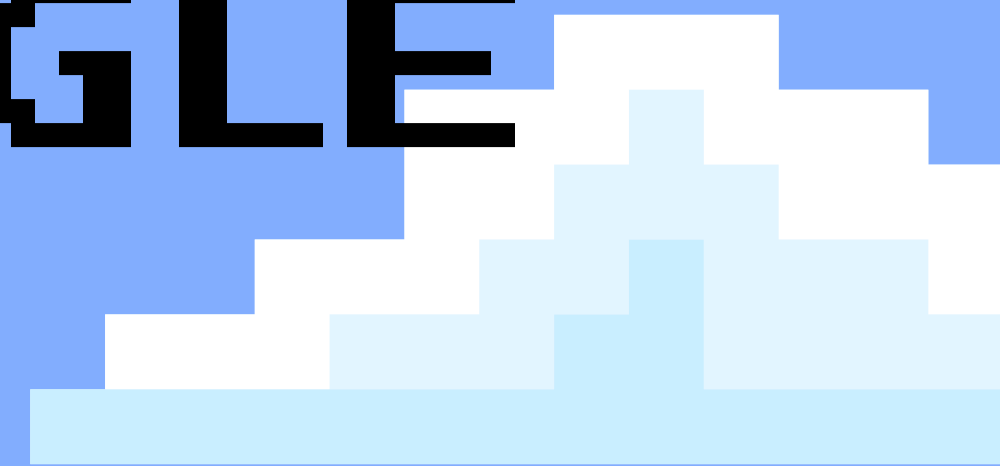

After a class session ends, all class teachers will receive an email summary of the class that includes basic class details, the number of times each function was performed, top web sites visited by the class, the top sites by each student, and more.

Teachers who wish to not receive the summary emails can disable them by going to My Account under the user menu in the upper right hand corner of most screens, and unchecking the box for Class session summary.
