Chrome, an [Internet browser](#) released by [Google, Inc.](#), a major American [search engine](#) company, in 2008. By 2013 Chrome had become the dominant browser, surpassing Microsoft's Internet Explorer and Mozilla's Firefox in popularity.

Chrome is based on the [open-source](#) code of the Chromium project, but Chrome itself is not open-source. The first beta version of Chrome was released on September 2, 2008, for [personal computers](#) (PCs) running various versions of [Microsoft Corporation's](#) Windows OS ([operating system](#)). The development of Chrome was kept a well-guarded secret until a Web-based "comic book" describing the browser was released just hours before links appeared on

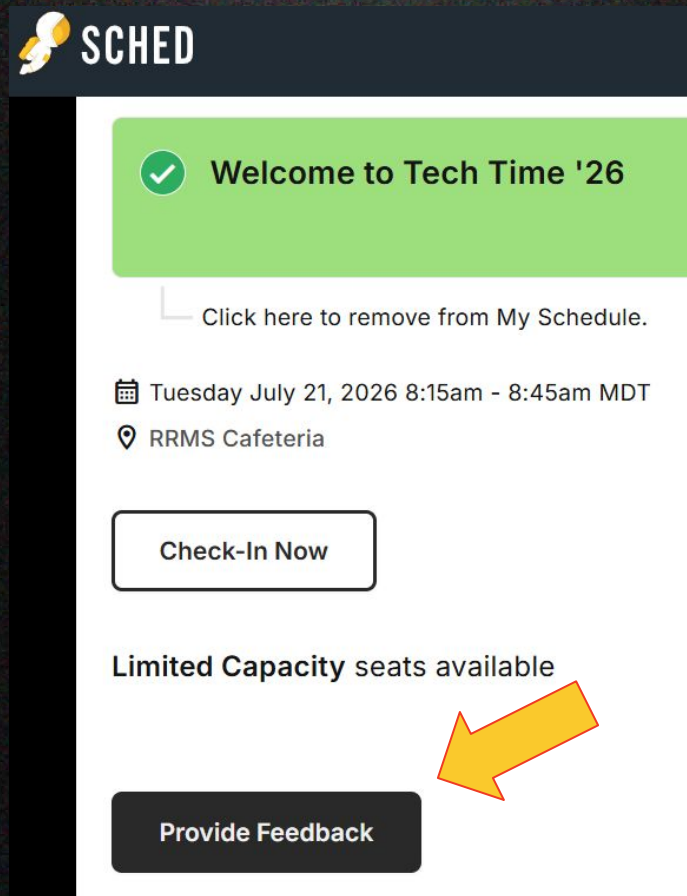
Memory Saver

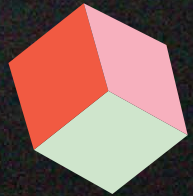
Keyboard Shortcuts



Ctrl+Shift+T	Opens the last closed Tab	Ctrl+N	Open a new Chrome browser window
Ctrl+J	Go to downloads window	Ctrl+Shift+B	Toggle bookmark display
Ctrl+H	Go to history window	Ctrl+W	Close the current Tab
Ctrl+Tab	Navigate Tabs	Ctrl+Shift+D	Saves all open pages as bookmarks in a new folder
Ctrl+K	To search quickly in the address bar	Space Bar	Scroll down the current web page
Ctrl+L	Highlights the URL in the address bar (to copy/paste quickly)	Ctrl+2	Opens the second tab open. Whatever tab you want to open, use that number

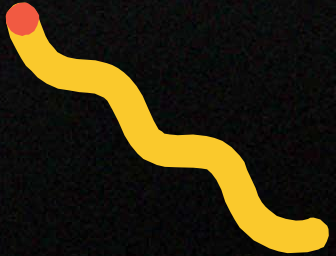

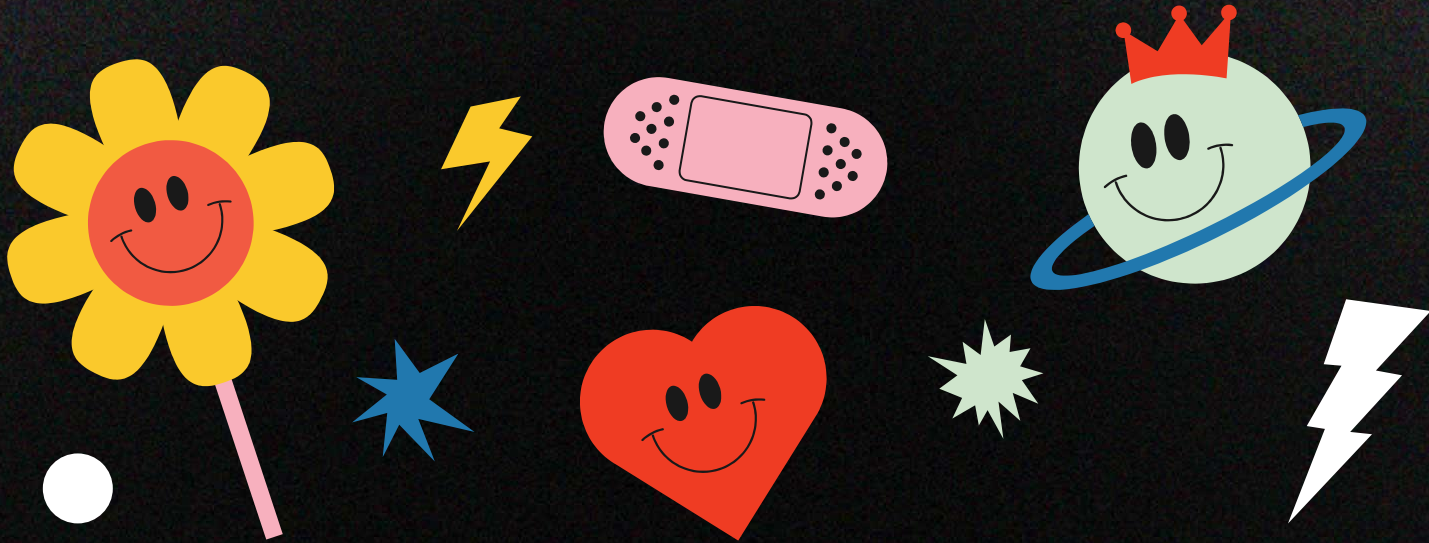
